Friendly Matches

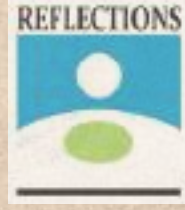
Friendly matches with other schools provided valuable exposure and experience.

So go forward with confidence, little Stars! Keep dreaming, keep shining, and always keep that wonderful spark inside you alive.

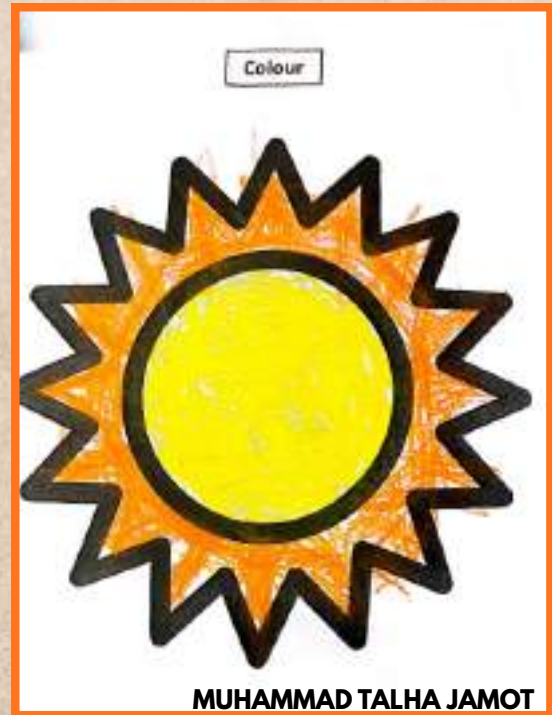
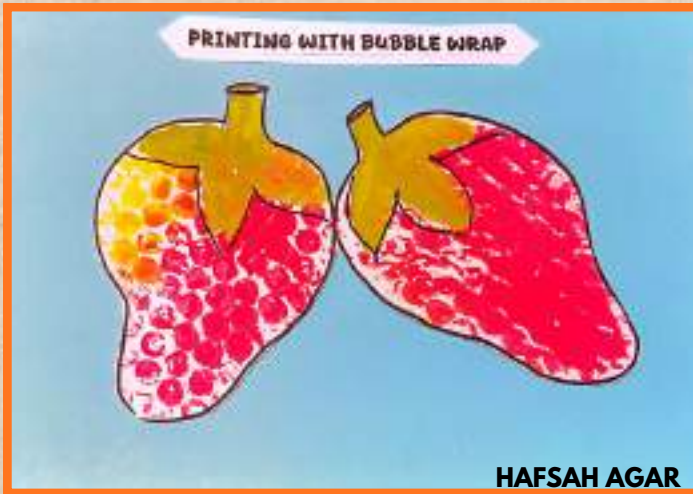
